

DIVESTING INVESTMENTS POLICY

1. Purpose

- 1.1. This policy aims to influence and support shifting from fossil fuel based energy option to renewable energy sources towards decreasing on-campus carbon emission.
- 1.2. This policy intends to regulate investments in renewable energy made by the government in Tashkent State Agrarian University (hereinafter, TSAU).

2. Rationale

- 2.1. This policy has been formulated to contribute to reduction of carbon emission and promote energy efficient sources.
- 2.2. This policy recognized that continuous use of fossil fuel leads environmental problems, such global warming, threatening to biodiversity and air pollution.

3. Scope

- 3.1. This is an internal document formulated for reporting strategies and plants for divesting investment from carbon-intensive energy industries.
- 3.2. This policy applies to partners, donors, and production organization owned by TSAU. Accordingly, they are asked to invest in more renewable energy than in fossil fuel based energy.

4. Policy

- 4.1. Formulate long-term strategies on shifting to more efficient energy option and increase investment in eco-friendly production sector.
- 4.2. More investment in energy-efficient production and renewable energy sources to reach Sustainable Development Goals 7 and 13.
- 4.3. Replace all office devices with energy efficient devices to save energy use and achieve low carbon emission.

- 4.4. Financial supports to scientific investigations on advantages and disadvantages of both renewable and non-renewable energy options towards increasing awareness of student, staff and visitors of TSAU.
- 4.5. Weekly broadcast of scientific findings on efficient energy options through the university websites and challenge/messenger groups.

5. Monitoring and compliance (optional)

Any non-compliance with this policy will be reported to representative of TSAU.
